### LEADERSHIP OPPURTUNITIES

Within the BMST there is the oppurtunity for training and mentoring in leadership. What does it look like?

**Berakah Miniatures Trainees** - The new & younger inexperienced members of the team are generally placed as trainees under a Co-Handler and Lead Handler.

**Berakah Miniature Co-Handlers**  
Those who have spent a year on the team progress to the role of Co-Handler. They assist the Lead handler in all areas of caring for and working the horse as instructed and under supervision of Lead Handler.

**Berakah Miniatures Lead Handler** - Once the student has demonstrated a good grasp of horse handling and the ability to work with fellow students, they may be assigned the role of Lead Handler. This involves more responsibility and organisational skills to work with their team, the horse with assistance of the Group Leader and BMST staff.
